Partnership for Emergency Planning, PEP, is a partnership of private businesses and public sector service agencies. It is a public/private partnership of individuals who come together to share and become better prepared to respond to an emergency and recover from a disaster.

PEP was founded in 1989 as a non-profit organization dedicated to emergency planning issues in the metropolitan Kansas City area. Membership has expanded over the past years and now includes hospitals, school districts, municipalities, federal, state and local emergency management associations, and some of the largest corporations in Missouri and Kansas. Membership representation now reaches out from the core of Kansas City to other outlying regions.

PEP maintains a goal to facilitate the exchange of information between the private and public sectors and promote community-wide awareness of the importance of emergency planning and disaster recovery.
